A Dozen from the 1904 Transcontinental Run Album

Messrs. Whitman and Carris drove a 1904 Type-A cross engine Franklin from San Francisco to New York between August 1st and September 3rd, 1904. This was a record-breaking achievement and The H.H. Franklin Club is fortunate to have an album of 97 original pictures from this 4500-mile trip. These photographs were professionally scanned and adjusted at high resolution with each picture file being about 25 Mbytes.
