
A Dozen from the 1906 Transcontinental Run Album

Messrs. Whitman, Carris, Daley, Bates, and Harris divided into two teams to drive a 1906 Type-H six-cylinder Franklin from San Francisco to New York between August 2nd and 17th, 1906. This was a record-breaking achievement, and The H.H. Franklin Club is fortunate to have an album of 94 original pictures from this 4100-mile trip. These photographs were professionally scanned and adjusted at high resolution with each picture file being about 25 Mbytes.

A dozen of the pictures have been selected as a teaser in this file but the entire selection is available in a larger file on the Club's website and the high-resolution scans are available to club members upon application to the librarian (library@franklincar.org).
