Saint Augustine became the gateway to the New World when the Spanish settled in 1565, and the city has preserved much of its rich history since then.

We start the tour off strong! Arrive early on Wednesday to tour Castillo de San Marcos, before getting acquainted with historic downtown on a walk down St George Street. Reconnect with old friends, make new ones, at registration and get settled in before heading back out to soak up the sun! When the sun sets, an optional (and highly encouraged) ghost tour is available for those wanting to learn about the cities spooky history.

Thursday will begin our first full day of touring, with a short drive across the street to the Ponce de Leon Archeological park, home to the legendary Fountain of Youth. The park offers a look into what life was like when Ponce de Leon settled here, as well as the native history before the Spanish arrived. There will be a catered lunch at the park followed by a tour down to the Saint Augustine Lighthouse. If the Fountain of Youth doesn't rejuvenate those knees in time to climb the lighthouse, there are plenty of sites on the grounds to explore. We'll grab a bite at the sandwich shop there before driving down the Anastasia Beach(\$8 per car) to watch the sunset hit the clouds over the Atlantic with a glass of wine.

By Friday you'll want to have worked most of the Franklin Funkies out of your car because this will be "The Grand Tour", a drive down Florida's scenic coastal highway A1A toward Flagler Beach. We will be stopping at Washington Oaks State Park (\$5 per car) before continuing down the coast. The day will end with a banquet and awards ceremony to commemorate the Trek at the Saint Augustine Classic Car Museum.
